

NOTICE

The City of Ukiah – Volunteer Fire Department will begin burning off vacant lots and other properties which pose a fire hazard to adjacent homes or businesses. If you are interested in this service, please leave a message with the City of Ukiah at 541-427-3900. Include your name, number, and the property location. The Fire Chief or other member of the Department will contact you, and have a look at the property to discuss some options. Please note that this service (controlled burning) is free of charge. However, any preparation work, which is required prior to burning, will be the responsibility of the property owner.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Property must be within the city limits.
- 2) Property must be cleared to natural vegetation.
- 3) Small to medium sized piles are allowed, but must not contain any manufactured wood products (plywood, etc) or painted/stained wood. Additionally, no household trash of any kind, plastic, rubber, or other HAZMAT, is allowed in the piles or the burn area.
- 4) If possible, trim weeds or mow along borders and around any items you do not want included in the burn operation.
- 5) The landowner will need to be present during the burn operation.
