REGULAR MEETING

Motion made by Linda Kerr second by David Durfey to approve April 2019 Minutes with the correction of paragraph Page 2 "I anticipate several weekends of work and approximately 20 volunteers total". Unanimous Approval

PUBLIC CONCERNS COMMENTS:

- Dave Durfey expressed concerns if there are enough fire hydrants for the Van Dorn properties. Steve Draper said there were fire hydrants within 500'
- Camas Creek Flooding Clint Barber reported that the Oregon Department of Lands timeline has been extended. We received approval from the CTUIR and Oregon Department of Fish & Game to work within a certain period of time. Tommy Mentzer asked about reporting to FEMA emergency disaster. Steve Draper reported that the Emergency Manager Tom Roberts with assistance from the Umatilla County Commissioners were going to report to the State that the emergency is three counties and the Umatilla County Commissioners have gone to the State Capital with the Disaster Plan. Steve Draper reemphasized that the lift Station will still be endangered and more than two manholes west of the Lift Station had water pouring into them further taxing the pumps in the Lift Station. The manhole covers will need to be replaced.

- The City of Ukiah would like to thank everyone for their quick response and assistance in filling sandbags and operating equipment when Camas Creek was flooding.
